Open call for participation in a 2-day artist lab

At a time when opinions and perspectives collide and divide, INTER-ACTIONS as a cultural organization & dance company would like to offer platforms to work together embracing different experiences and perspectives. In one **2-day artist lab** We want to approach the topic artistically with a community of dance creators: **What methods are needed to create respectful places and atmospheres? How do we facilitate encounters? How can we promote peace, empathy, humanity, togetherness and harmony in our own artistic processes? And how do we confront polarity, division, conflict, hatred and dehumanization?** Artistic methods, which we will approach as case studies, will be shared and exchanged resulting in five short project ideas for interventions in public spaces to be developed in the following month of September.
